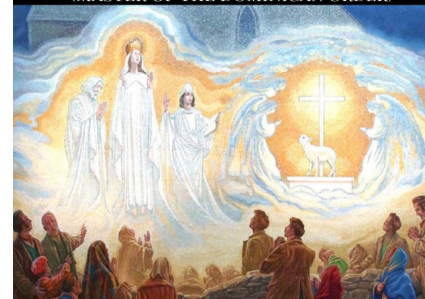
Men's and Women's Groups at St Saviour's:

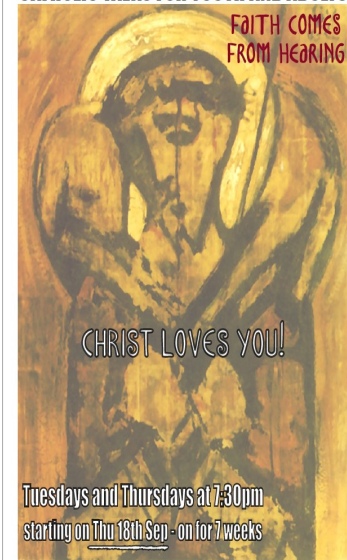
