

Reflection: In today's gospel Luke had a clear vision of what the Kingdom of God would look like. He actually outlines some of it in Mary's great prayer, the Magnificat, in particular, "He puts forth his arm in strength, and scatters the proud-hearted. He casts the mighty from their thrones and raises the lowly. He fills the hungry with good things, sends the rich away empty."(Luke 1:46-55).

It is easy to read these words and let them wash over us, but even a moment's reflection shows the seismic shift in thinking and acting required to live them. They call for a total reversal of the values our present world accepts as normal and correct. The values of our world: pride, wealth, power, success, and their inevitable results, injustice, poverty, hunger, war, will be reversed in the Kingdom of God - the proud will be scattered and lose their influence, the powerful will be thrown from their kingdoms of false domination, while those forgotten by society will receive justice and recognition. The rich will lose the luxuries and comforts of wealth, allowing the poor and hungry to be fed and prosper.
