IBTS issues urgent appeal for 2,000 additional blood donations over the next 4 weeks

The IBTS is seeking an additional 2,000 blood donations over the next 4 weeks to maintain the national blood supply as some blood groups have fallen to under 3 days of stock.

"We are asking regular donors to make an extra effort to attend their nearest clinic (appointments available online). For the longer term, we would also urge donors to please consider giving blood if they are eligible before they go on holidays this summer.

"New donors are especially welcome, and we would encourage anybody interested in giving blood to visit :

We would particularly encourage new donors of African heritage to join the National blood donor panel to help us diversify the donor base and get better blood type matches for patients."
